INACTIVE ENDOMETRIUM WITH PSEUDO-DECIDUALIZED STROMA CONSISTENT WITH EXOGENOUS HORMONAL EFFECT.

FRAGMENT OF CERVICAL GLANDS WITH MILD ACUTE INFLAMMATION.

A. In formalin labeled "endocervical curetting": Is a 1.5-0.5 and 0.1 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with bloodtinged mucus. Totally submitted, 1 block.

- B. In formalin labeled "endometrial curetting": 2.1 x 1.5 x 0.2 cm aggregate of tissue fragments admixed with clotted blood. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- C. In formalin labeled "peri urethral left": 1.8 x 0.5 x 0.3 cm tan tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- D. In formalin labeled "ureteral sacral ligament": 0.5 x 0.4 x 0.2 cm tan tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- E. In formalin labeled "ovarian fossa left": 0.6 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm tan tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- F. In formalin labeled "cul-de-sac": 0.6 x 0.4 x 0.3 cm tan tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- G. In formalin labeled "right ureteral sacral": 0.5 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm tan tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- H. In formalin labeled "ovarian fossa right": 0.6 x 0.5 x 0.2 cm pink tissue piece. Totally submitted, 1 block.
- I. In formalin labeled "peri-ureteral right": 0.9 x 0.3 x 0.2 cm tan-red tissue piece(s). Totally submitted, 1 block.
- J. In formalin labeled "uterine fibroid": 1.1 x 1.0 x 0.5 cm rubbery, tan-pink tissue piece. The specimen is bisected to reveal uniform tan-white surfaces. Totally submitted, 1 block.
